

STUDENT ENTRY RULES

The Student Art Show is open to those currently enrolled in a High School or Middle School of Northwest Florida.

All work must be original, entirely the work of the entrant, and completed within the last two years. Entries must not be copies of copyrighted or published paintings or photographs or derivatives (e.g. giclée) of any work. Artwork that has won an award in a previous Arts & Design Society sponsored exhibit is not eligible.

All art mediums are acceptable. Installations are not eligible for entry. Works by students need not be framed, but must be matted or suitably mounted. If framed, work must be securely wired with eye screws placed 1/3 the length from the top of the work and wired. No saw tooth or center hangers are allowed. If under glass use plexiglass only.

The Arts & Design Society reserves the right to refuse any work considered unsuitable for a family-oriented venue. Work deemed unsuitable will not be accepted.

All work including work sold during the Fair, must remain on display until the night the Fair closes. Students removing their work before closing time will not be permitted to enter any Arts & Design Society art shows for the next five years. Work not for sale must be clearly identified as such on entry form (NFS).

A 10 % commission will be charged for works sold. The student is responsible for Florida sales tax on any sales.

LIABILITY

All reasonable care will be taken in handling and displaying works entered. Security will be provided through 12:00 noon Monday, October 31. The Northwest Florida Fair and the Arts & Design Society will not be liable for any claim, loss or damage.

STUDENT AWARDS

High School - Cash prizes will be awarded to First, Second, and Third Places. Honorable Mentions – Ribbon only.

Middle School - Cash prizes will be awarded to First, Second, and Third Places. Honorable Mentions – Ribbon only.

ENTRY FEES

The entry fee for High School and Middle School students is \$ 2.00 per item. Each student may enter up to five (5) pieces of artwork. The entry fee is submitted with artwork and completed entry form at the Fairgrounds on Registration day.
